

Honors for Associate Degrees

Honors at graduation are awarded to students based on their grade point average (GPA) earned in their total undergraduate work as follows:

- *** Highest Honors (3.75 to 4.00 GPA)
- ** High Honors (3.50 to 3.74 GPA)
- * Honors (3.30 to 3.49 GPA)

Special Distinctions

Students who have earned Honors are distinguished by a gold braid. Students in the Honors Program are distinguished by a special medallion and ribbon. Students in Alpha Gamma Sigma International Honor society are distinguished by gold stoles with burgundy writing.

Emergencies

The Campus Safety Department has personnel on duty to provide aid in the event of an emergency. The emergency number is 707.476.4111.

Regalia

The colorful attire worn by the graduates, faculty, and the officers of the college on the occasion of commencement has roots in medieval history. The gown is an adaptation of the robe of a friar priest, the hood of the monk's cowl, the mortarboard cap of the skull cap worn to protect tonsured heads against the drafts of medieval classrooms.

The Gown The gown indicates the highest degree held by the wearer. The bachelor's gown has long pointed sleeves. The master's gown has long oblong sleeves. The doctor's gown is distinguished by very full sleeves with three black or colored velvet bars and by velvet on the front.

The Tassel The position of the tassel on the cap indicates whether or not the graduate's degree has been conferred. If the wearer has graduated, the tassel is worn on the left. If not, it is worn on the right. The tassel on the doctoral cap is gold.

The Stole Students wearing the broad gold stoles are members of Phi Theta Kappa, the international two-year college honor society that recognizes outstanding scholastic achievement.

The Cord Students wearing the gold cords over the gown are graduating with honors.

The Hood The hood worn by those with masters or doctorate degrees bear the colors of the university from which the degree was received and the discipline or major subject area.

Guest Speaker: Mr. David Bender

*National radio talk show host,
political activist, author and television producer*

College of the Redwoods commencement speaker David Bender has lived a highly successful life as an author, broadcaster, and political activist by following his heart.

“My message to the graduates will be about passion,” he said. “You can achieve anything if you know what motivates you in the deepest personal way—much more than a career, job or education path. Passion is what gets you out of bed in the morning or what keeps you awake at night. If you understand what moves you deeply, it will guide you throughout your life.”

Bender, who became a Humboldt County resident four years ago when he moved to Trinidad, is currently the co-host, along with Robert F. Kennedy, Jr. and Mike Papantonio, of the long-running, nationally syndicated radio program, “*Ring of Fire*.”

Bender’s four-decade career as a political activist began at the age of 12 when he took a “leave of absence” from the seventh grade to become a full-time volunteer in the presidential campaign of Senator Robert F. Kennedy.

Four years later, as a high school reporter, Bender covered the presidential campaigns of Richard Nixon, George McGovern and Hubert Humphrey. He was literally a “boy on the bus,” traveling in the company of such journalistic legends as Walter Cronkite and Eric Sevareid. Later, he became a key aide to the legendary liberal activist Allard K. Lowenstein, the former New York congressman who was a pivotal figure in both the civil rights movement and the anti-Vietnam War movement.

Bender has also been deeply involved in both the television and music industries, serving first as a senior executive in the production company of musician Stephen Stills and later, as vice president of Roseanne Barr and Tom Arnold’s television production unit. After Bill Clinton was elected president in 1992, Bender became the Democratic National Committee’s liaison to the entertainment industry.

In 2003, Bender returned to politics as a senior advisor in the presidential campaign of Vermont Gov. Howard Dean. He subsequently joined Air America Radio to become the host of his own long-running talk show, “Politically Direct with David Bender.” Bender was also Rachel Maddow’s “political guru,” appearing regularly on The Rachel Maddow Show on Air America. Maddow now has a show on MSNBC.

David Bender is also the author or co-author of four books, including “*Stand and Be Counted*,” a chronicle of artist activism in the music industry written with legendary musician David Crosby. He also scripted and co-produced the two-part, four-hour television documentary of *Stand and Be Counted* that aired on TLC.

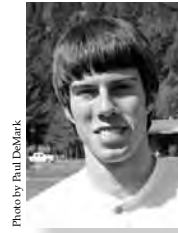

From homeschooler to valedictorian

As someone who was homeschooled by his parents since he was 5 years old, Ian Snyder had never experienced a traditional classroom setting until he began attending College of the Redwoods.

CR was clearly a good fit for Ian as he is graduating after three years as the college's 2010 valedictorian, or outstanding student.

"I like the atmosphere at College of the Redwoods," Ian said. "I like the relatively small teacher-to-student ratio. It's kind of easy going."

Ian, who grew up in Ferndale and Rio Dell, will attend Humboldt State University in the fall and major in environmental resources engineering. He said CR has prepared him well for transferring to HSU.

"I know and like all of the math and science faculty I've had at CR," Ian said. "I want to eventually get into civil engineering and I think the HSU environmental resources engineering program will give me the training I need."

Ian said he did not know what his direction would be until his second year at CR and he appreciates the flexibility that attending CR provided him.

"CR is a good stepping stone because it allows you to figure out what you want to do before you transfer to a four-year university," he said. "I didn't know, but I kept on track with my academics with the help of the teachers and other students."

"I recommend CR as a good starting point. It is a whole lot cheaper than going to a four-year school and the quality is high. And I really liked staying in the North Coast area, another reason why I'm going to HSU."

Ian, a self-taught piano and guitar player who is a Boy Scout leader, will receive a \$1,500 scholarship for earning the valedictorian honor. Ian has also been selected by the CR Mathematics Science Scholarship Committee, as an outstanding CR mathematics student, to be the recipient of the California Mathematics Council Community Colleges (CMC3) Foundation \$400 scholarship this spring. One outstanding mathematics student at CR is selected for the honor of receiving this award every three years.
