

## **UC TRANSFER ADMISSION GUARANTEES**

Eight campuses of the University of California now extend to all 109 California Community Colleges the opportunity to participate in the Transfer Admissions Guarantee (TAG) Program. Qualifying community college students may have a TAG agreement issued up to one year in advance of their transfer to UC. The agreement outlines the requirements to be completed prior to transfer and the conditions which must be satisfactorily completed to receive a guaranteed admission to the campus and to the major program at the University of California.

Each campus establishes the terms, conditions, and requirements for issuing a TAG and includes the students responsibilities regarding G.P.A., course completions, application processes, and updates required to maintain and complete the agreement.

The TAG process is designed to assist the student in planning, preparing, and accomplishing the transfer process in an efficient, effective, and uncomplicated manner.

### **FALL 2010 UC SANTA CRUZ TRANSFER ADMISSION GUARANTEE (TAG)**

UC Santa Cruz will be accepting TAG agreements for fall 2010 between August 1 and October 15, 2009. They will accept admission agreements for fall quarter only. To apply for the TAG Program, students must be enrolled at a participating community college and must have completed a minimum of 30 UC transferable semester (45 quarter) units of course work with a minimum 3.00 G.P.A. ### **FALL 2010 UC DAVIS TRANSFER ADMISSION GUARANTEE (TAG)**

UC Davis will be accepting Transfer Admission Guarantees (TAG) for fall 2010 from September 1-30, 2009. Students must have completed at least 30 semester transferable units at the time the Transfer Admission Guarantee is written. Students who have completed fewer than 30 semester units do not qualify for a Transfer Admission Guarantee. These students should apply for admission through the regular application process. If you are interested in a Transfer Admission Guarantee with UC Davis, contact the CR Transfer Center immediately (at least a few weeks before September 1) to begin the process.
