Frequently asked questions about applying for CR scholarships:

Can I download a scholarship application?

You can download the application in Word or PRF format at www.redwoods.edu/district/scholarships.

What is considered a complete application?

Incomplete applications will not be considered. A complete application will include:

- ✓ Scholarship application (3 pages) – attached forms
- ✓ Personal Essay
- ✓ Unofficial CR transcripts
(Letters of recommendation are no longer required)

Can I apply for more than one CR scholarship?

How do I get a copy of my unofficial CR transcripts?

Unofficial CR transcripts can be accessed through WebAdvisor. Log in to WebAdvisor, click on “Students”. Under the heading “Academic Profile”, click on “View Unofficial Transcript”.

Student Personal Essay

This is one of your most important scholarship documents!

You will have the greatest chance of success if your essay is well written and clearly demonstrates your educational and career goals. Ask your friends, parents, instructors, or counselors to read your essay and offer their suggestions.

Your personal essay gives you the opportunity to inform the Scholarship Committee of important qualities about yourself. This essay should reflect your values and background. It may be helpful to share cultural and family history along with other information important to you.

What should be included in your personal essay?

- ✓ Your educational and career goals; careers that you are considering and why.
- ✓ Reasons for your choice of major.
- ✓ Specific qualifications you may have for your chosen field of study.
- ✓ Your accomplishments, i.e., honors, publications or exhibits, success in competitions, etc.
- ✓ Why you feel this scholarship is important to you.
- ✓ Your family background; are you first in your family to attend college?
- ✓ Events or people that have been important to you.
- ✓ Something that you have learned about yourself or the world around you that is especially interesting.
- ✓ Jobs that have been helpful in your educational development.
- ✓ Why you are going to college and what you hope to gain from this experience.

Limit your essay to 2 pages, single-sided and double spaced.
