

FINANCIAL AID ELIGIBLE ACADEMIC PROGRAMS

Federal regulations require that all students receiving federal student aid enroll in and make progress toward an eligible educational goal and an eligible program. All AA/AS/AS-T programs are financial aid eligible programs, but only those certificate programs listed on this form are *currently* eligible for financial aid. If you are not in an associate degree or transfer program, and are in one of the certificate programs not listed below, you are NOT eligible for most types of financial aid (grants, loans, work study). However, you *may* be eligible for the Board of Governor's (BOG) fee waiver (if otherwise qualified).

You must have an eligible educational goal in addition to being enrolled in an eligible academic program. Eligible educational goals for financial aid purposes are: Transfer with AA/AS; Transfer without AA/AS; AA/AS without transfer; Vocational Certificate without transfer.

If you plan to earn both an associate (AA/AS) degree and a certificate, declare the associate degree as your current program. Even though an AA/AS degree may be eligible, the certificate in that same area may not be (i.e. ECE).

Federal regulations limit the amount of units students may attempt; so take courses applicable to your program. This limit applies whether you received financial aid funding for the courses or not!
