Course Description

PC 832 Arrest & Control is a course certified by the California Commission on Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST). It fulfills the minimum arrest and control training requirements specified in Penal Code Section 832. Topics include laws of arrest, search and seizure, report writing, defensive tactics, crime scene evidence, ethics, and community policing.

Because this course is designed to provide practical hands-on training in police tactics, participants in this course will engage in physically demanding classroom training exercises that include a risk of injury to the participant.
