### Designation of Doctor

Under the amended Worker's Compensation rules of California (SB 899) employees retain their ability to pre-designate their personal physician in the unlikely event they are injured on-the-job. However, the provisions have been amended. As amended in Labor Code Section 4600 a pre-designated physician is the employee's primary care physician and has previously directed the medical treatment of the employee, and who retains the employee's medical records, including his or her medical history. The physician must be a medical doctor licensed pursuant to Chapter 5 (commencing with section 2000) of Division 2 of the Business and Professions Code. **The physician must also agree to be pre-designated.**

To designate your personal physician for the initial treatment of occupational injury please complete this form, **have your physician agree to be pre-designated** and return this form to Human Resources. The pre-designation must be on file prior to any occupational injury
