Phlebotomists and Phlebotomy students must be able to perform specific essential functions with or without reasonable accommodation.

- Communicate information and ideas verbally so others will understand
- Listen and understand information and ideas presented verbally and in writing
- See details at close range and at a distance and see clearly enough to read hand-written and computer generated communications
- Stand on your feet for long periods of time and quickly and repeatedly bend, stretch, twist and reach
- Lift objects up to 25 lbs.
- Make precisely coordinated movements of the fingers of one or both hands to grasp, manipulate, or assemble very small objects
- Apply safety and infection control standards learned in the program to maintain a safe and clean environment for patients and self
- Interact appropriately with patients, physicians, peers and supervisors
- Attend all class sessions or make up days

Students are required to wear uniforms, appropriate safety apparel, and meet industry/business standard grooming requirements including nail, hair, makeup, hygiene, body-odor, and tattoos and piercing. The dress code prohibits visible tattoos and facial piercing.
