STUDENT COVID-19 QUICK FACTS

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

- Upload vaccination status (one-time) in the College of the Redwoods Campus App; OR
- If un-vaccinated (with exemption**), complete daily pre-screenings in the Campus App or with a health screener on campus.
- After completing the health screening, receive a pass through the Campus App <u>OR</u> a wristband from a health screener.
- Use QR codes and the Campus App to scan into classrooms and other areas for contact tracing purposes.







If you have a confirmed case of COVID-19:

- ▶ Record your COVID status in the "**Report Test Results"** section of the Campus App.
- ▶ Investigation of exposed classroom begins. Students are notified through the Campus App or Student Email, verification of attendance/enrollment is done.

Return-to-Campus Criteria:

All COVID-19 positive cases, regardless of vaccination status, previous infection, or lack of symptoms:

- Stay at home for at least 5 days.
- Wear a well-fitted mask around others for a full 10 days, especially indoors.
- Test on day 5.
- Isolation can end after day 5 if asymptomatic and test taken on day 5 is negative.
- If unable to test or choosing not to, isolation may end after day 10 (without symptoms).
- If fever is present, isolation should continue until fever resolves.
- If other symptoms persist, continue to isolate until after day 10.
- Clearance from the County Health Department, a medical professional, or a negative test will be required*.
 - *PCR test is preferred, but antigen tests are acceptable. Record your COVID status in the "**Report Test Results**" section of the Campus App.
 - **Applications for exemptions to the vaccine mandate must be approved before coming to campus.

If you have been exposed to a known COVID case

(within 6 feet for greater than 15 minutes in a 24 hour period):

- ► Contact College of the Redwoods Interim COVID Manager **Jason Maki** at (707)476-4550 or <u>Jason-Maki@redwoods.edu</u> immediately.
- ▶ Record your COVID status in the "Daily Pre-Screening" section of the Campus App.

Return-to-Campus Criteria:

Fully vaccinated persons (with booster or not yet booster eligible) who had close contact (within 6 ft. of positive case for an accumulated 15 minutes or more in a 24-hour period) and have **NO symptoms** may remain on campus. You should test as soon as possible and continue to monitor health. It is recommended to test again 5 days or later from exposure date or if symptoms develop. It is also advised to mask for a full 10 days.

Unvaccinated persons or those who are **vaccinated without a booster (and eligible)** who had close contact and have **NO symptoms** should Quarantine, test **as** soon as possible, and must wear a mask for a full 10 days. If test is negative may return to campus anytime. It is recommended to test again 5 or more days after the exposure date or if symptoms develop. Mask must remain for the full 10 days. If any test is positive must follow the positive case protocol.

ANYONE who had close contact **and developed** any COVID-19 symptoms cannot return until:

- Need to stay home and isolate for at least 5 days, mask around others for 10 days; test on day 5.
- Isolation can end after day 5 if asymptomatic and test from day 5 is negative. Mask must be worn for the full 10 days.

 Those who cannot test, or choose not to, must isolate for 10 days, and can return on day 11 (unless still symptomatic).
- Any exposed persons who develops symptoms must test before returning to campus. If test comes back positive, they must follow isolation protocols.

ISOLATE IF DIAGNOSTIC TEST IS POSITIVE:

- Stay home for at least 5 days; Mask for 10 days around others, especially indoors; Monitor symptoms.
- Isolation can end after day 5 if the person has no symptoms and a diagnostic test taken on day 5 is negative.
- If the person is unable to test (or chooses not to) then quarantine can end after day 10.
- Isolation should continue if a fever is present and/or other symptoms are not resolving.

Clearance from the County Health Department, a medical professional, or a negative test will be required* to return to campus.

*PCR test is preferred, but antigen tests are acceptable. Record your COVID status in the "**Report Test Results**" section of the Campus App.

**Applications for exemptions to the vaccine mandate must be approved before coming to campus.
