45 minute lunch break. Pizza and drinks will be available at the snack bar.

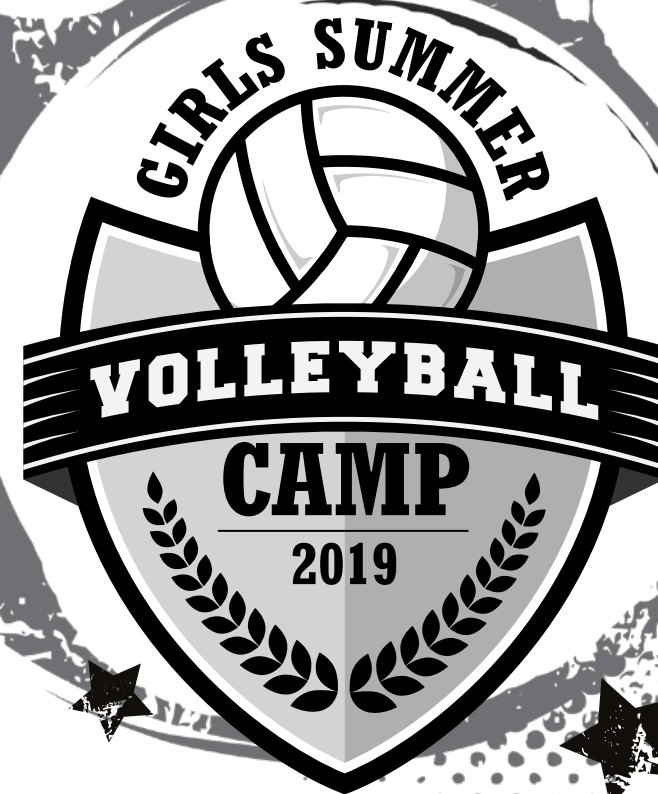
