## Registered Dental Assisting Program Applicant Information

### Program Eligibility:

- **Applicants must have a satisfactory cumulative Grade Point Average meeting or exceeding a 2.0.**  
Eligible applicants must be in good academic standing. Student on Academic Probation, Level 1, Level 2, or students dismissed from the College due to unsatisfactory academic performance are not eligible for the Program.
- **Applicants must have a valid Student Identification Number from College of the Redwoods.**  
Eligible applicants must have a College of the Redwoods student identification number. This requires applicants to additionally apply to the College, an application can be completed online at <http://www.redwoods.edu/Admissions/guide> and a student identification number will be e-mailed.
- **Applicants must meet basic math and English skill requirements.**  
Eligible applicants must be competent in basic English and math skills. Applicants must be eligible to enroll in English 150, or have completed English 350, or equivalent. Additionally applicants must be eligible to enroll in Math 272, or have completed Math 301, or equivalent.
- **Applicants must have a high school diploma or equivalency.**  
Eligible applicants must include official high school transcripts or equivalency, such as a GED attached to this application for acceptance into the Dental Assisting Program. This is an accreditation standard requirement of the Commission on Dental Accreditation of the American Dental Association.

### Program Application Filing Period:

**Applications are accepted February 1<sup>st</sup> through August 1<sup>st</sup> each academic year.**

Eligible applications are accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis. Incomplete applications will not be processed.

### Program Requirements:

- **Acceptance:**

Applicants accepted in the Program will be notified by letter in mid- May. This is done by certified mail, and is sent to the address indicated on the application. At the time of open registration, accepted students are then automatically registered in the Dental Assisting Program courses by the Program Coordinator. **It is then the responsibility of the student to pay all registration fees.** Payment is paid through the student's WebAdvisor Account. Students failing to pay will be deregistered from the Program and positions will not be held.

- **Additional Fees:**

Applicants accepted in to the Program will be required to pay additional fees. Please refer to the Dental Assisting Program Student Fees Handout provided with this application packet. Information about available financial aid can be found at <http://www.redwoods.edu/financial-aid>.

- **Orientation:**

Applicants accepted in to the Program will be required to attend a mandatory orientation held one week prior to the beginning of school. For more information about the orientation, uniforms, physicals, vaccinations, and student fee requirements please refer to your letter of acceptance when it arrives in early May.

- **Nutrition and Communications:**

Applicants accepted in to the Program will need to complete Nutrition (HO15) and a communications class (COMM1-Public Speaking or COM6-Small Group or COMM7-Interpersonal Communication These classes may be taken concurrently with the Dental Assisting Program courses during the fall and spring semesters or during the summer session prior to enrollment in Program. **Program Information:**

• **Accreditation:**

The Dental Assisting Program at College of the Redwoods is accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation of the American Dental Association and approved by the Dental Board of California. This allows graduates to be eligible for the Registered Dental Assistant (RDA) exam, for State licensure, and the Certified Dental Assistant (CDA) exam, for National certification.

• **Employment:**

Career opportunities for our graduates are exceptional! According to the US Department of Labor, dental assistants are expected to be among the fastest growing occupation. We work closely with our local dental community to provide internship and jobs opportunities for our students.

• **Hours:**

The Dental Assisting is offered each academic year, beginning in the fall semester, 990 hours are completed, including 330 clinical hours. Classes are held Monday through Friday during typical working hours. Students enrolled in the Program return in early January, two weeks prior to the beginning of the spring semester to allow for scheduling flexibility.
