



Admission Requirements

International Program

International Students must meet all admission requirements before their applications will be considered. If you do not meet admission requirements, your application will be denied.

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

All application materials must be submitted by the deadline for the semester in which you wish to begin attendance. If you do not meet the deadline, your application will be considered for the next available semester. New student applications for the Summer Session will not be considered.

Fall Semester Deadline: June 1st
Spring Semester Deadline: November 1st

HIGH SCHOOL COMPLETION:

International students must have successfully completed high school prior to admission at CR.

ENGLISH PROFICIENCY:

International students must meet English Proficiency standards as indicated in the table below.
