

Study Guide for “¿Cómo Se Dice?”

- Pronouns -

I think this book is hard to navigate in general, and especially when you are trying to learn pronouns.

MY STUDY SUGGESTIONS:

- Use post-it notes to mark the first page of each chapter in the book, and write which chapter number it is on the post-it. This lets you access the chapters very quickly.
- Use the grid below as a reference for personal pronouns. Notice the differences and similarities between them.
- If you do not have a firm grasp on each different use of pronouns (such as direct object or indirect object), I recommend that you study each one individually. At the bottom of the grid below there are page numbers listed, for the book and workbook. You can review the use of the pronoun in the book, then do practice exercises in the workbook to assess your knowledge.
- I also recommend putting post-it notes on the page where each of the pronoun types is listed in the book.
- When working in the workbook, sometimes it is a good idea to write the answers on another sheet of paper so that you may go back and try them again without the answers being right in front of you. Also, remember the answer key book is available at the reference desk in the library, if you want to check your answers.
- When you think you have a grasp on each different use of pronouns, there is a practice review on page 152 in the workbook. This includes all the types of pronouns.
