**ADVISING NOTES:**

The Bachelor of Arts degree with a Liberal Studies Elementary Education major at Humboldt State requires a minimum of 120 units of which a maximum of 70 semester units can be from the community colleges.

The major for elementary teaching blends three elements- the General Education Program, the courses required in the Liberal Studies major, and the courses required for teacher preparation- which can result in a B.A. in Liberal Studies Elementary Education.

**ASSOCIATE DEGREE REQUIREMENTS:** For an Associate in Arts degree with a Liberal Arts major you must complete a minimum of 60 semester units with a 2.0 GPA or higher.

**Humboldt State Admission Requirements**

The California State University requires a total of 60 transferable units for admission, including 30 units of general education requirements. All of General Education Area A & B4 must be completed for a letter grade; C or higher for transfer. Students must obtain the CSU General Education requirement sheet so that they can plan their transfer program (both major and GE requirements) at CR appropriately.
