

**2018 – 2019
 Cost of Attendance (Budget/Expenses)**

The expenses listed below are estimated costs for attending College of the Redwoods & are intended to give you a general idea about cost. *They are approximate only & may differ from student to student.*

Financial aid rarely covers the full cost of attendance; be prepared to pay a portion yourself. You also need to have money to pay up-front for books/supplies, even if you expect to receive financial aid. All financial aid will go toward balances owed to CR (tuition/fees, housing costs, etc.) first. No funds are disbursed to you unless all money owed to CR is paid in full.

Your Expected Family Contribution (EFC) is calculated based on your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) information & is used to determine your financial aid awards. Most financial aid awards are based on financial need, the difference between expenses/budget & your EFC. The resulting number is your financial need & is the maximum funding that can be received for the academic year. This does NOT mean you will receive this maximum in financial aid.

Fees for ALL students are based on full-time enrollment (12 units per semester) at \$46 per unit, plus semester fees (\$20 health fee, \$10 student fee, \$10 technology fee); (24 units per year x \$46 per unit + \$80 = \$1184). If you enroll in more than 12 units per semester, your costs will be higher.

***On Campus housing charges include \$4559 in housing costs & \$3672 in meal plan costs.**

****Both non-residents & OR Exchange students pay fees (\$1184 per year depending on enrollment) & will pay an additional amount as shown below:**

Non-resident tuition is based on full-time enrollment at \$259 per unit (24 units per year x \$259 per unit = \$6126). If you enroll in more than 12 units per semester, your costs will be higher.

Approved Oregon (OR) Exchange tuition is based on full-time enrollment at \$71 per unit (24 units per year x \$71 per unit = \$1704) rather than the non-resident fees. If you enroll in more than 12 units per semester, your costs will be higher.

Note: The costs listed above for fees, non-resident/OR exchange tuition, & residence halls are subject to change without notice. The non-resident & Oregon exchange fees include a per unit capital outlay fee.
