


Need a Canvas Account?

Even if you don't have access to CRs Canvas site yet you can start learning and using Canvas by creating a free Canvas Instructure account. This is a good idea even if you already have access CR Canvas. You can experiment in a course; create new lessons, change settings, pages and assignments and all without affecting students. If you create new lessons or modules at Instructure, you can then export them out to a file and import them into the live CR Canvas site.

If you decide to create a sandbox account on the Instructure Canvas server, you will need to create a free user account by going to <http://canvas.instructure.com>

Click on the "Need a Canvas Account?" link, then follow the onscreen prompts to create a Teacher account (and don't forget to use an email address with a .edu domain).
