Truck Driving Program

General Information

1. **Application Packet** All applicants must submit the following with their application: Copy of valid California Driver's License, DMV Driving Record, DOT Medical Exam (all pages), Class A Permit, and negative drug screening results.
2. **Applications received without required documents** will be deemed incomplete and will not be processed.
3. **Eligibility for random lottery** is contingent upon negative drug screening.
4. **Computer Literacy-** Truck Driving students must possess sufficient computer literacy skills to complete the online theory portion of the program.
5. **Completed application packets** will be reviewed for lottery eligibility.
 - You will receive an email confirming your application packet has been received and is under review by the College of the Redwoods Adult & Community Education Office.
6. **Cost of the Program**
\$4,500.00 course fee, includes the following:
 - Registration
 - All instructional supplies
 - Online theory portion of the class
 - Behind-the-wheel training

Not included in cost:

- DOT Medical Exam
- Class A Permit
- DMV Driving Record
- Drug Screening
- DMV Driving Test

Selection Process

All eligible applicants are placed in the lottery and randomly selected. There are 4 seats available for each cohort. All eligible names will be drawn and notified of their place in the lottery.
