### Advising notes for applying external credit by exam scores:

#### When applying scores toward CSU GE:

- All external exams will be reevaluated at the time of the student's transfer, and each CSU campus and major is also allowed to make its own local decision for how external credit by exam is awarded. It is important for the student to research how their external credit would be awarded at their target school(s).
- If the student is transferring to the CSU system or needs CSU certification, it is <u>almost always</u> best to apply the student's AP and IB scores as the CSU system accepts them toward GE.
- The AP tables in CR's catalog show the standard applications when used toward CSU GE breadth or CSU GE
  certification.

## When applying scores toward IGETC/UC:

- Some scores may be given a different unit value for IGETC GE certification than is awarded toward UC admission. It is necessary to also account for how scores are counted towards UC admission here: https://admission.universityofcalifornia.edu/admission-requirements/ap-exam-credits/ap-credits/
- All external exams will be reevaluated at the time of the student's transfer, and each UC campus and major is also allowed to make its own local decision for how external credit by exam is awarded. It is important for the student to research how their external credit would be awarded at their target school(s).
- If the student is transferring to the UC system or needs IGETC certification, in most instances, it is <u>almost always</u> best to apply the student's AP and IB scores as IGETC accepts them toward GE.
- The AP tables in CR's catalog show the standard applications when used toward IGETC or UC GE breadth or IGETC certification, with may be different from application toward UC admission.

# When applying scores toward CR or CCC GE:

- If the student is getting a local degree or transferring to another CCC, it is <u>almost always</u> best to apply the student's AP and IB scores as the CCC system accepts credit toward GE.
- The AP tables in CR's catalog show the standard applications when used CCC GE breadth.
- CR local standard equivalencies or faculty course substitutions may be used for areas of emphasis to count toward a CR degree.

#### When applying CR local equivalencies:

- Students may choose a course equivalency, but it is very important to note that *credit may be awarded* differently for CSU or IGETC GE breadth, and will not be honored as the substituted course by other instructions after transfer.
- IB credit may not be duplicated. For example, if a student has an IB score that is equated with a CR course and also takes the CR course, no credit will be awarded for the IB score.
- Faculty can award credit at their discretion as a specific course through a course substitution.
- The number of units awarded for a course equivalency cannot exceed the number of units awarded toward CSU or IGETC GE breadth.
  - For example, a student may choose to use AP History toward a CR course equivalency for his/her major and follow CSU breadth. In this case, at CR only 3 units would be awarded for a history course equivalency, because a maximum of 3 units is awarded toward CSU GE breadth.
- If there are two course equivalencies for one AP score, the equivalency will be automatically determined by whichever provides the student the most benefit, unless otherwise noted on the form.
