

EDUCATIONAL GOALS AND FINANCIAL AID ELIGIBILITY

Federal regulations require students declare and make progress toward **an eligible educational goal** to be able to receive most* types of financial aid. An eligible educational goal confirms that you are working towards an Associate Degree or Certificate and clarifies whether you plan to transfer or not.

If you choose to change your educational goal, you can call the Counseling office at 707-476-4150 or send an email to counseling@redwoods.edu (include your name, student ID, birthdate and new educational goal selection). It may take up to one week for this item to show as received in myFinAid after your counselor updates your educational goal.
